ABOUT US: *New name* is a paediatric specialty interest group (SIG) under the auspices of the Australasian Infectious Diseases Society (ASID), established to promote child health in the field of paediatric infectious diseases.

MEMBERSHIP: All financial members of ASID with paediatric specialty interest

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- To promote the exchange of information and ideas in paediatric infectious diseases (PID) *e.g. via the “on-line” PID forum, ASID Paediatric SI link, regular meetings or updates*
- To communicate important paediatric infectious diseases updates *e.g “news bytes” via the paediatric “on-line” forum and the ASID Paediatric SIG link*
- To facilitate clinical guidance via guidelines, position statements or educational material
 - ◇ clinical care of children with infection
 - ◇ the prevention of infection in children (e.g prevention strategies in perinatal infections, childhood vaccinations)
- To promote education e.g. PID training, educational material, concise reviews
- To promote collaborative research
- To advise on paediatric SIG funding matters *e.g. WSPID funding, Perinatal Algorithm “royalties”, etc*
- To provide information on PID related matters for colleagues *e.g Medical residency or Fellowship inquiries, postgraduate degrees, position advertisements, promotion of PID events, identification of colleagues with specific sub-specialty expertise*
