

ACCOMPANYING PERSONS INFORMATION

The following document outlines the additional opportunities and associated expenses for accompanying persons. Each of these additional expenses can be paid for through the online requirements form. If you have already completed the form please contact the course secretariat to organise these additions.

Accommodation

Double Occupancy Charge: \$96.00

This fee applies if an accompanying person is staying during the included four night's accommodation of the course registrant. The fee includes four buffet breakfasts that occur during the course

Extra Night Double Occupancy Charge: \$275.00

This fee applies if you are staying for more than four nights; it is applied for each extra night. This fee includes breakfast for two people. Please note there is a fee available for extra nights, single occupancy.

Family Accommodation Fee: \$175.00/\$430.00

This fee is applies if you require family accommodation (two bedrooms, two bathrooms) during the course. The accommodation is only available at another hotel (Port Douglas Sea Temple Resort). It is your responsibility to organise transfers between both hotels and no breakfast is included. The \$175 fee is a per night fee during the course (Monday – Thursday nights). The fee charged outside the course dates is \$430.00 per night.

Cots and rollaway beds can be arranged through the Course Secretariat; however additional costs may be incurred.

Transfers

Transfer can be arranged for accompanying persons to and from Cairns Airport and Thala Beach Lodge. The transfers cost \$30 per person each trip. You will be required to select on the requirements form whether these are required. If they are arriving or departing on separate flights please contact the course secretariat.
